

NIG/FarmWeb Motor Policy

Please read this document carefully. Full terms and conditions can be found within the Policy Document.

The NIG/FarmWeb Motor policy is underwritten by Royal and Sun Alliance Insurance Ltd, an Insurance Undertaking, and will run for 12 months or as shown on the policy schedule.

Please refer to your policy schedule for full details of any endorsements or excesses that may apply.

You are under a duty to make a fair presentation of the risk to us before the inception, renewal and alteration of your policy.

This means that you must tell us about and/or provide to us all material information or tell us and/or provide to us sufficient information to alert us of the need to make further enquiries to reveal such material information. This information needs to be provided in a clear and accessible manner.

Material facts are those which are likely to influence us in the acceptance of the terms or pricing of your policy. If you have any doubts as to whether any information is material you should provide it to us.

Failure to disclose any material fact may invalidate your policy in its entirety or may result in your policy not responding to all or part of an individual claim or class of claims.

In order to comply with your duty to make a fair presentation you must also have conducted reasonable searches for all relevant information held:

- within your business (including that held by your senior management and anyone who is responsible for your insurance); and
- by any other person (such as your broker, intermediary or agent or a person for whom cover is provided by this insurance)

If any changes in circumstances arise during the period of insurance please provide full details to the broker, intermediary or agent acting on your behalf.

If you wish to cancel the contract at any other time, please contact the broker, intermediary or agent who arranged the Policy. Any return of premium will be made in accordance with the Cancellation Condition.

How to make a claim

Please contact, in the first instance, the broker, intermediary or agent who arranged the Policy, providing full details, as soon after the incident or circumstance as possible. Please quote your Policy Number.

When making a claim, it is very important that you meet all of the requirements of the policy, particularly Condition 3. If you don't, we may not pay part or all of your claim.

How to complain

If you have an enquiry or complaint arising from your Policy, please contact the broker, intermediary or agent who arranged the Policy for you. If the broker is unable to resolve your complaint or it is regarding the terms and conditions of the policy they will refer it to NIG.
